Subject: Safety Training

WHEREAS, many projects require certain basic training and or certifications and or testing in order to work on such project and

WHEREAS, the IUPAT must remain competitive in order to capture and maintain market share and

WHEREAS, all IUPAT members should be trained in basic Health & Safety classes including, but not limited to OSHA 500, First Aid/CPR, respirator fit/pulmonary function test, and other basic training which is more craft specific.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the IUPAT strongly urges all trustees of Local Finishing Trades Institute/Joint Apprenticeship Training Fund programs to amend their trust documents to make it mandatory for the Funds to provide training required for needed certifications and upgrades for jobs which participating employers are or will be performing. Such amendments should also provide authority to the Finishing Trades Institute to oversee and audit the local JATF's progress and performance in offering such programs, and if necessary, for the FTI to provide the needed training and certifications at the local JATF facility at the local JATF's expense.
