3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Motion made and passed unanimous to accept minutes of June 19, 2009.

4. OLD BUSINESS

A. IUPAT Resolutions

George Galis, IUPAT General Secretary-Treasurer, recapped the resolutions that were put together through the Industrial Painting Committee and their effect on the industry. George thanked Chairman Mark Chuplis and the committees for helping the resolutions come to reality. George’s recap included resolution no. GEB 31 - mandatory advanced or upgrade journey person training, resolution no. GEB

35- JATC funds to amend their trust documents to make it mandatory for the funds to provide training required for needed certifications and upgrades resolution no. GEB 36- JATFs to amend their trust documents for reciprocal training and resolution no. GEB 37 – picture ID card listing training and certification. Discussion followed about the training being paid by a fund and the union employee using that training in another area. George made it clear to the committee that the training will follow the man.

B. Labor Productivity Study

Chairman Mark Chuplis provided an update on the Labor Productivity study and strongly urged the committee to participate.

5. NEW BUSINESS

A. FTI update

Chairman Mark Chuplis asked John Burcaw, of the FTI, to provide an update. John discussed the relationship with FTI and SSPC on the coating applications program. John discussed on the particulars of the program and how it was created to meet the industry standards. Currently, there are 73 instructors and FTI will be like a sub-contractor to SSPC in providing this to our membership.

John reported that the curriculum was done and they were prepared to start certification. John indicated that they are looking to separate industrial painting from commercial painting by creating a “Coating Applicator Specialist” training program at the apprenticeship level.

Bill Shoup of SSPC responded to a committee question on getting a government standard in Canada. Discussion followed. Bill also addressed the requirements for retesting after the agreement between FTI and SSPC is completed. Bill indicated that everyone will need to retest for certification. Bill was asked if this training was available to the non-union and he indicated it was.

Dan Penski, Director IUPAT/FTI, reminded the committee that the FTI mission is to develop instructors and build tool boxes for the local JATF.

Mike Burke was asked to be added as a member of the committee.
